HARNESS RULING #13

MEETING: Century Downs, Balzac, Alberta, Canada

April 16, 2024

In the opinion of the Board of Judges, OWNER/TRAINER/DRIVER, JACQUES WILFRED LAMBERT, PERM. ADD.: RED DEER COUNTY, ALBERTA, CANADA, D.O.B. OCTOBER 14, 1982, did violate HORSE RACING ALBERTA Rule 137(a)(b); A horse from a jurisdiction, other than Alberta, which is racing in that jurisdiction under an EIPH Program must race under the EIPH Program in Alberta unless the horse, has been in an EIPH Program for more than 100 days, and is decertified in accordance with these rules; and HORSE RACING ALBERTA Rule 286(a); A person violates these rules who, in the opinion of the judges/stewards board, conducts themselves in a manner prejudicial to the best interest of horse racing; by causing the horse "CAPTAIN VAN GOGH" to be an unnecessary scratch (missed Lasix) in Race 3 on Saturday, April 6, 2024.


PENALTY: JACQUES LAMBERT is hereby FINED THE SUM OF ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00).
